## COROMANDEL PIG HUNTING CLUB RULES

- 1) New Member. The name of any person desiring to become a member shall be submitted to the committee by a club member. Who may admit him/her or reject him/her These new members must attend the AGM.
- 2) Life Members. To become a Life member the persons name must be submitted and past at a committee meeting. Then put forward at the next AGM and voted on by all Members present.  
A Life member has all the privileges as a full financial member. (Membership Plus Pines levy.)
- 3) Junior Member. A junior shall be 16 years and under. Free membership. (Club only, Not pines.)
- 4) Hunting Pines. Before entering the pines;
  1. Be a full financial member.
  2. Abide by the rules of the club and the Forestry.
  3. Dogs must be registered.
  4. Dogs must be identifiable ie. Branded.
  5. Ear tattoo's are not acceptable.
- 5) Poaching. Any member caught poaching in pines, caught hunting pines without full membership Penalties. First Offence: Full membership cancelled for two years.  
Second offence Membership cancelled for life.
- 6) These penalties also apply to any member who brings the Club into disrepute.
- 7) All dogs belonging to Club members must be Kiwi Aversion Trained.
- 8) One decent pig per day (60lb) this rule is for the **WHOLE** forest.
- 9) A Social Member is a member who has all of the rights of a full member except they will not receive a Forest Permit and cannot hunt in the Whangapoua Forest, (Ernslaw One.)

### “PRESIDENTS REPORT”

Hi Everyone,

Hello to the 2018 pig hunting season. This years AGM had another poor turn out. Thanks to those that made the effort, it was appreciated. A number of members who reside locally failed to turn up which I think is not acceptable when a good number of members from afar made the effort. You all know who you are and you all know when the meeting is, so make the effort. The committee will be reviewing this before the next AGM.

Last year the committee passed a motion that all subs are to be paid by April 10<sup>th</sup>. Failure to do so means forfeiture of membership and gives the committee room to allow new members into the Club. This has come about because the Secretary for years has chased members for subs and by the end of the season, so called members still have'nt paid.

Last season the Forestry had 22 gates vandalized which cost them a lot of money to repair. They have asked that we as a Club be more vigilant with our observing of strange vehicles at gates, check them for permits and advise the committee members of the registration numbers if there is no permit displayed.

There have been a few cases of parvo-virus reported in Paeroa so take extreme care and get your dogs vaccinated. I have'nt heard of any dogs with go-slow this year but that does'nt mean that it's not about.

There was a report of a hunter who got separated from his hunting party and failed to make the rendezvous at a specific time. He turned up several hours later but I think it highlights the need to add one of your dogs tracking collars on a mates handset which gives you an advantage if something had happened to a lone hunter and speed up the finding of said person. Just food for thought as dogs normally stay with their owners. Real bad luck if the dog is killed.

Unfortunately due to matters beyond our control, there is a short turn around from receiving your permits and returning them to the Secretary and then getting them signed by the Forest Manager. Please bear with us and we will try to fix it next year.
